Blue Jean Ball Scholarships	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GPA 2.8 or > • Baccalaureate or Masters student • Financial need • Be in good standing <p>*Recipients of Blue Jean Ball Scholarships are expected to work at least 8 hours at the next scheduled Blue Jean Ball (to assist with set-up, to assist with clean-up, and/or at the actual fundraising event)</p>
Linda C. Belcher Endowed Memorial Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GPA 3.0 or > • Non-Traditional, rising senior • Characteristics of Linda C. Belcher: caring, compassion, morals, education, and determination • Financial need; can be waived if there is no suitable candidate
Gordy Mead Britton Foundation Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GPA 2.5 or > • Financial need; can be waived if there is not a suitable candidate
Reuben Herzfeld Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GPA 3.0 or > • Full-Time nursing student; minimal load of 12 semester hours
River Region Medical Alliance Scholarship Endowment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GPA 3.0 or > • Full-time Traditional Senior
Nancy Carter McDonald Scholarship Endowment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GPA 2.5 or > • Possess a good potential to succeed, innate ability, motivation, caring, and determination • Be from a disadvantaged, underrepresented, or minority group • Be "striving against all odds" (e.g. self-supporting, single parent, working a full-time job as a full-time student)
Mary Oliver McLemore Annual Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must have maintained a permanent residence for a period of at least one year before enrollment in the counties of Montgomery, Elmore or Autauga
Medical Society of Montgomery County Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GPA 3.0 or > • Full-time student in AUM School of Nursing
Irma B. Moore Endowment Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GPA 3.5 or > • Baccalaureate or Masters Nursing student – preference given to a Masters Student • Exceptional academic qualifications • Full-time student • Potential and characteristics to make a significant contribution to the profession of nursing
Virginia C. Muckler/Gerard Elliot Nursing Annual Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GPA 3.6 or > • Nursing Major • Write essay outlining career goals • Financial need • Veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces (preferred); if a veteran cannot be identified, the criterion may be waived.

Tina Gross Portis Award	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Graduating Senior Nursing Student • Exhibits academic performance, leadership, compassion, Integrity and professionalism • One recipient annually
Ray and Sarah Roton Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Traditional rising junior or senior in the School of Nursing • Demonstrates satisfactory academic progress • Demonstrates financial need as verified by the Office of Financial Aid • Preference to a student from the Montgomery and surrounding area
Spirit of Caring Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nursing student at AUM • Demonstrate good academic standing • Financial Need • Recipient(s) should demonstrate behaviors based on Jean Watson's Caritas Processes (10 caring practices): • Practice loving kindness and equanimity, authentically present, sensitive to self and others by nurturing individual beliefs, personal growth, and practices. Developing helping-trusting –caring relationships. • Promoting and accepting positive and negative feelings in care relationships and authentically listening to another's story. • Using creative scientific problem solving to meet the needs of others. • Engaging in genuine teaching-learning experiences that address individual needs and learning styles. • Creating a healing environment for physical and spiritual needs. • Potentiating alignment of mind-body-spirit by respecting and assisting with basic physical, emotional and spiritual human needs. • Slowing down and allowing space for unexpected wonder within the practice of nursing.

Patti Wallace Enhancing Lives Annual Scholarship	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GPA 3.0 or > • Resident of Alabama • Financial need; If suitable candidate cannot be identified financial need can be waived • Shared beliefs with Patti Wallace- Putting patients first, enhancing patients and employees lives; provide only the best quality of care to patients
